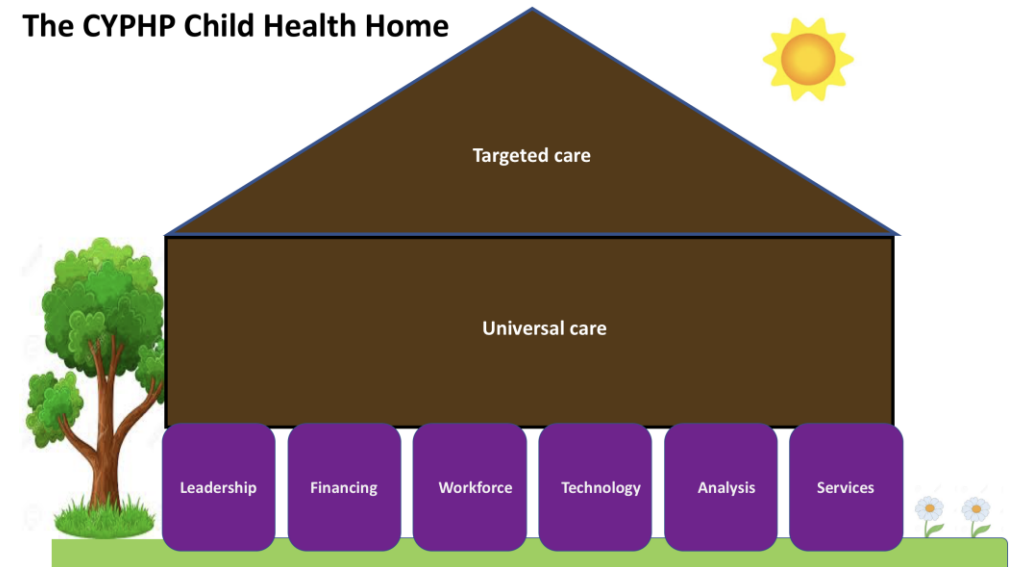
The CYPHP Child Health Home

Did you know?

- If the UK were among the best in Europe, up to **5 children's lives could be saved each day.**
- Children with **physical health conditions often have hidden emotional problems too**, which can affect their school and home life.
- Around one in three children is living in poverty, and this number is increasing. **Poverty causes ill health and prevents children from reaching their full potential in life.**
- Improving children's health is **investing in the future.**

Better care and support to improve children's health in Lambeth and Southwark

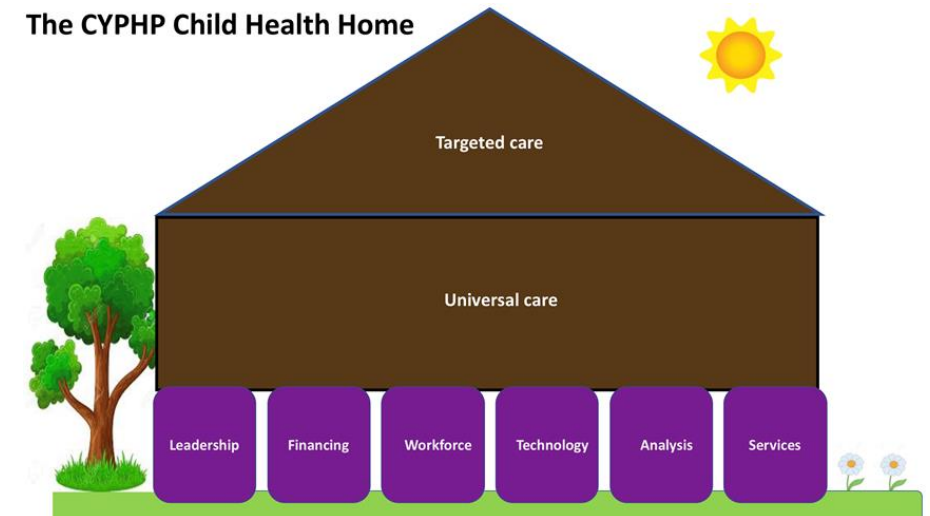
Children with ongoing conditions benefit from CYPHP's **targeted care**.

- ✓ Currently focused on asthma, eczema, constipation, and epilepsy.
- ✓ Care tailored to each child's physical and mental health needs in the context of their family and social conditions.
- ✓ CYP health teams provide care for the whole child.
- ✓ Health Checks and Health Support Packs provide supported self-management advice for families.

All children from CYPHP's **universal care**.

- ✓ Health promotion.
- ✓ Emotional resilience building and mental health first aid at school.
- ✓ Age-appropriate care for young people.
- ✓ Support for parents and professionals in managing common problems and minor illnesses.
- ✓ Clinics delivered by GPs and Paediatricians working together in primary care.

We provide *support for existing services and new services* for children.



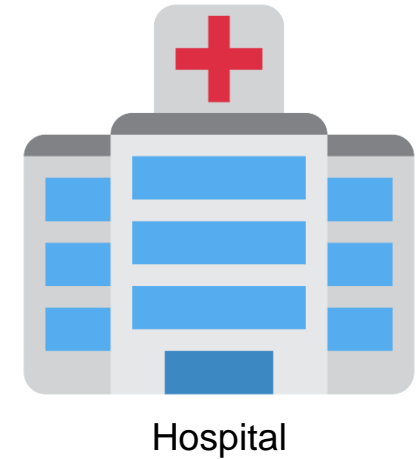
Parents and families can self-refer children with ongoing conditions for CYPHP care.

How do you refer?

Patients can self-refer, by visiting www.cyphp.org/health-check and completing the CYPHP Health Check.

Professionals can refer:

1. Give patients the CYPHP Health Check website link (as above).

To support access to care, patients will be invited into CYPHP through the **GP call-recall service**.

Which CYP can you refer?

Any child with an ongoing condition

CYPHP is starting with 4 tracer conditions:

- Asthma
- Eczema
- Epilepsy
- Constipation

What is a Health Check?

Health Checks ask about a child's health and wellbeing. The information helps the CYP health team to deliver tailored care for mind, body, and social context.

What is a Health Support Pack?

Resources and top tips for improving, monitoring and managing health conditions.

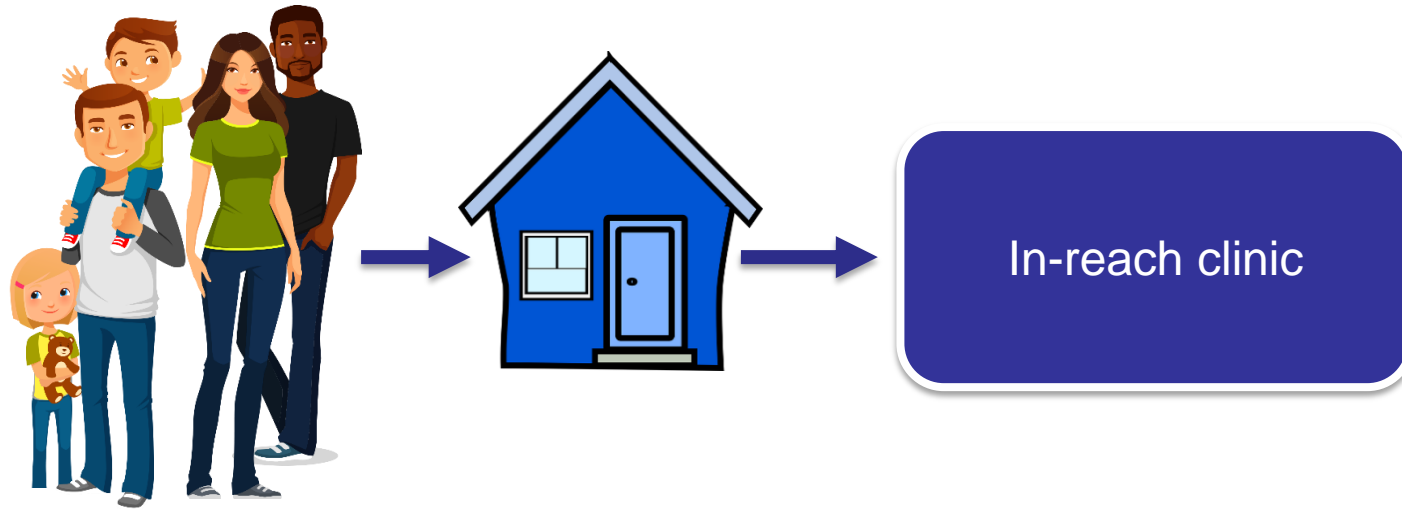
What is CYPHP Care?

Tailored care for mind, body, family and social context, for children with ongoing conditions. Care is delivered at or close to home, by a specialist CYP health team.

Is CYPHP care available in my area?

Everyone has CYPHP support now. Over two thirds of GP practices in Lambeth and Southwark have CYPHP care, with more to come as we roll out in stages.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is CYPHP In-reach?

Part of “universal care” available for children with any condition. Children are referred to In-reach by GPs, but instead of hospital outpatients, In-reach clinics are held close to home in GP practices. Families are seen faster, with multidisciplinary care from GPs and paediatricians working together to deliver expert care.

Is CYPHP care available in my area?

Everyone has CYPHP support now. Around half of GP practices in Lambeth and Southwark have CYPHP care, with more to come as we roll out in stages.

What does this mean for me as a GP?

Based in local GP surgeries, GP colleagues work with hospital general paediatric consultants (from Evelina London and Variety Children's Hospital@King's) to assess and treat children and young people under 16 years in the same appointment.
