Streamlined pathway for direct referral to the service

Children using their reliever inhaler or having school absence as a result of asthma can be referred **directly** to the service

Welfare officer and School Asthma Link Nurse – key to the pathway

Monthly asthma record

Welfare officers record salbutamol use and absences due to asthma

Monthly record returned to asthma team. Child's initials and DOB only

Asthma CNS inputs data onto spreadsheet

- Using salbutamol on 4 days or more in one month
- 3 or more days absence in one month
- Absence from school more than one month in any three month period

Email dialogue with school nurse/school asthma lead

School nurse arranges a review +- referral to GP or Children's Asthma Service



Integrated Pathway


School Asthma Link Nurse – key to the pathway












Readmission rate – all CCGs
